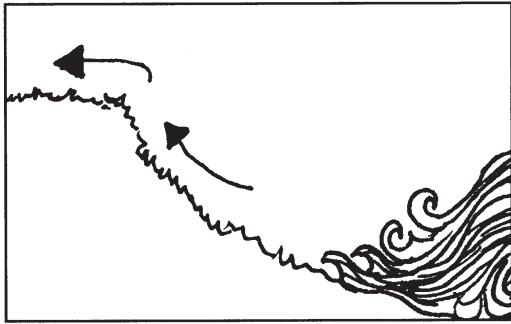




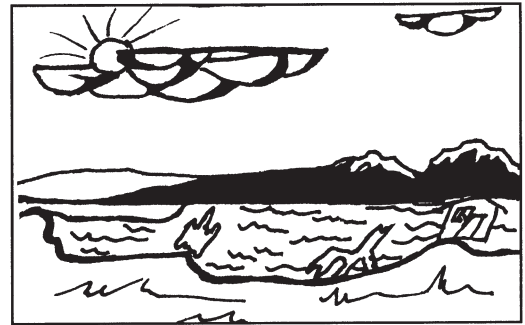
Flood Safety



Stay Safe When it Floods

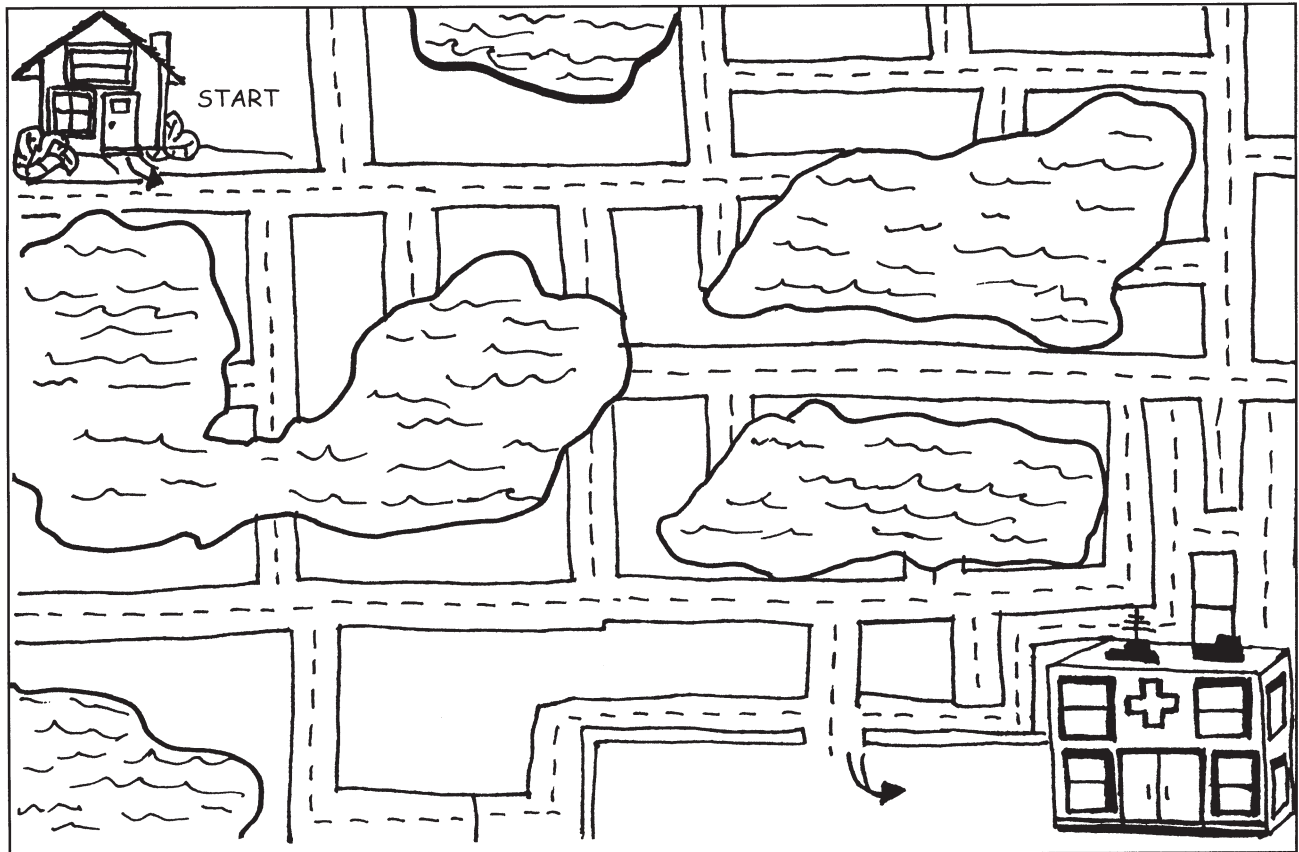


If there is a flash flood in your area, move to higher ground right away.



Stay away from flood water. It is very dirty and can have a strong current.

During a flood, stay away from flooded streets because they are very dangerous. Help the family get from their house to the Red Cross shelter without crossing flooded roads.

If you know a thunderstorm is coming, stay indoors.



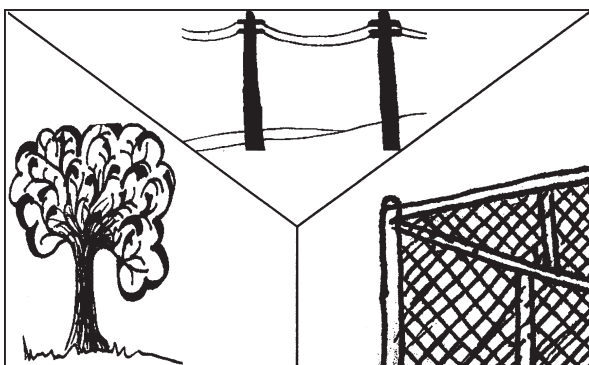
Learn the signs of a thunderstorm: dark clouds, lightning and thunder.



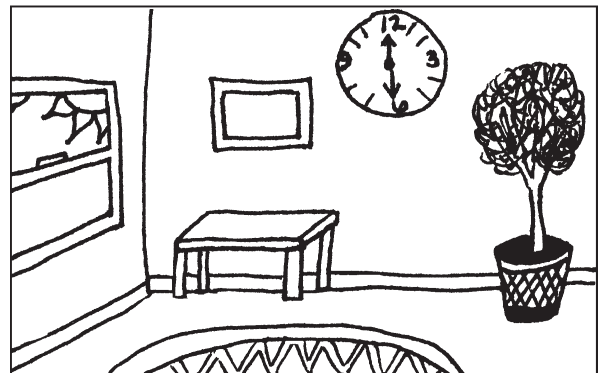
If you are outside when a storm comes, go inside right away. A car is also a safe place.



If you are in the water, like a lake or pool, get out right away and go inside!



Stay away from things lightning can strike like trees, fences, phone lines, and power lines.



Wait indoors at least 30 minutes after the storm ends before you go outside.
